

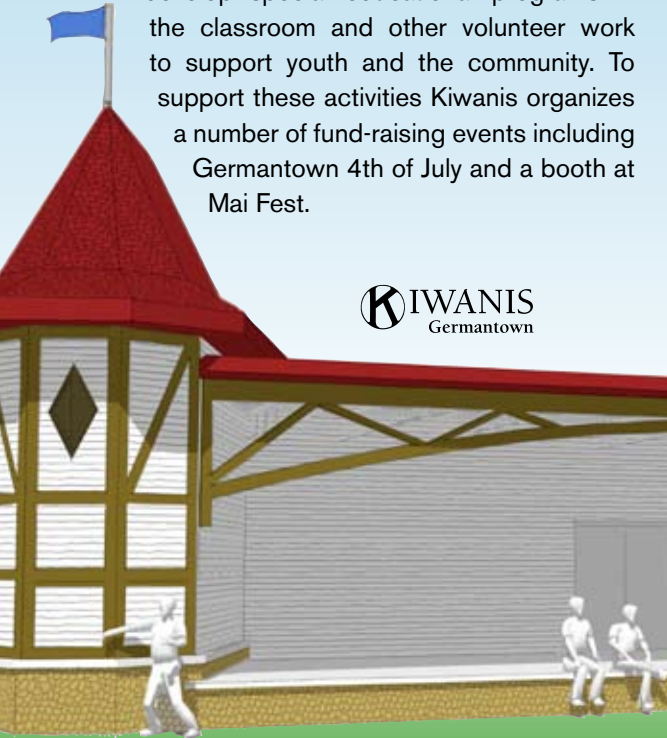
WHAT IS KIWANIS?
